
From the Co-ordinator's Desk:

Layers of Soil Grade II Activity

It is no secret that children and soil pretty much go hand in hand. Children usually love to find a dirt patch and make some mud and dig or romp in it. While they might find playing in it fun, they may be surprised to learn that soil is the basis for life and growth! Teaching children why "Caring for the Planet Starts from the Ground". Children will learn that without soil we would not be able to grow crops or other useful plants, support livestock, or have materials for building shelter! Healthy soils also store and filter water, recycle nutrients and help us to deal with the negative effects of climate change by storing large amounts of carbohydrates Soils are named and classified based on their horizons, The soil profile has four distinct layers: 1) O horizon 2) A horizon 3) Subsoil 4) Soil base. The O horizon has freshly decomposing organic matter - humus - at its

Justice is something we all employ, Unaffected by hate or joy. Giving others a helping hand, Not to benefit one, but the land.


Unbiased yet undefined, Something to seek and try to find. What is fair and what is good? Strive to do as we should.

Effects of climate change
